Notes on Committee meeting on 09/03/79

Held at Prince Room Restaurant
Selegie Complex

At 6.00 p.m.

- Present at the meeting were Mr Jack Page, Miss Barbara Leong and Mr Mohamed Saleh. Absent were Dr Bernard Tan, Mr Anthony Lee, Dr Chen Mun, Dr Jim Poo and Mr Alec Whittaker.
- It was agreed that it is not necessary to refund money back to members. Mr Page had spoken to the Registrar of Societies and was informed that if there is no other matters then there would be no further delay.
- CIRCULARS : Dr Chen Mun did not analyse the questionnaires so we cannot make any definite decisions. We hope that the results will be ready by the next meeting. Mr Mohamed Saleh pointed out there is no necessity to call for a General Meeting now since we have not received any complain from members. Since we have waited so long we might as well wait until the end of the next month before we hold a General Meeting.
- Mr Page informed us that "The Adam Osborne Seminar & Exhibition" will be in Singapore for 2 days on 15 & 16 May, 1979. The talks and exhibition will be on Microcomputer. We were further informed that leaflets will be circulated to members in our society.

"The Adam Osborne Seminar & Exhibition"

- 1) Cost per delegate:- \$200 per daily session or \$370 for both sessions.
- 2) A display will be organised & exhibitions. (Some companies will be exhibiting their products).

Suggestions made by Mr Mohamed Saleh :

- 1) Billing system & programming - we will set out a few teams and do feasibility studies. Later we can submit results of the studies to the committee members. The committee will decide whether it is feasible to take in the project.
- 2) Group purchasing of computers - Mr Page pointed out that it is dangerous to do group purchasing. E.g. The Southern California Computer Society has tried but it was a chaos.
- 3) Send special forms to members who are interested in software and from there ideas can be exchanged. Send newsletter to members and find out whether the members would like to contribute articles. We can start a software library right away. Mr Mohamed Saleh has agreed to design the forms.

The meeting was adjourned at 7.30p.m.
